Indulgences for All Souls Week. An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the 1st to the 8th of November; on other days of the year it is partial. A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful who on November 2, as well as on the Sunday preceding or following, and on All Saints' Day, piously visit a church. In visiting the church it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary also to fulfill the following 3 conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father. A plenary indulgence can be acquired only once in the course of the day.
